# COVID-19 Vaccination Information

## Booster vaccine for age 12-17 (3rd dose)

Twelve to 17-year-old Kobe residents who have received their 2nd dose of the Covid-19 vaccine can now get their booster shot (3rd dose). The number of Covid-19 cases among teens has been increasing, so please consider vaccinating your teen(s) after consulting with your doctor. Please note that vaccination is not compulsory.

Vouchers for the booster vaccine are mailed out after 6 months have passed since the second dose. You can schedule the vaccination once you have received the vaccination voucher.

The vaccine brand for this 3rd dose is **Pfizer**.

### ◆ Vaccination venues & scheduling

**Clinics and hospitals that administer the Pfizer vaccine:** Follow the administering clinic/hospital's procedures for scheduling a vaccination.

**City Hall Bldg. 1 (24F) & Noevir Stadium Kobe:** Schedule the vaccination online or call the Covid-19 Vaccination Call Center

**\*Parental/guardian consent and accompaniment is required for vaccination.**

### What to Bring

- ① Personal ID (foreign residence card, health insurance card, etc.)
- ② Vaccination voucher & health questionnaire (combined form)
- ③ Maternal and Child Health Handbook
- ④ Prescription booklet (if the child has one)
